## FROM THE COUNCIL SECRETARY'S DESK

Happy May everyone!

I never understood people's desire for the "Ordinary Time" season of the liturgical calendar until I was on council during Holy Week! Thank you to all of the volunteers & teams who made those services so special. How joyous it is to have Pastor Tim leading us during this time! How wonderful it was to see so many of your families return to be with you at Easter!

Now that Holy Week is behind us, the council has some "to-do's" that are pretty high up on our priority list. Executive is meeting on May 3 to review the church's policies, procedures, job titles, volunteer descriptions, etc., which will then be brought to the entire council for approval. The Education Committee (currently Vicki Hall) is very excited to bring VBS back to Trinity but needs YOUR help pulling it off! Please speak with her if you are available to serve in this way.

California state law AB 506 requires all churches to have child & vulnerable population training for ALL volunteers who may work with those populations. That includes Sunday school teachers, VBS teachers/helpers, as well as anyone on a visitation team who may enter a home "on behalf of" Trinity. Many of us did get fingerprinted a number of years ago, but that no longer suffices. The program that our synod has chosen is called "Safe Gatherings." Pastor Tim will be spearheading the push to get all of our volunteers trained and ensure that we are meeting all state requirements.

Worship in the park will be coming up in June—date to be announced. At this event, we will be putting together "hygiene kits" for the homeless. Keep an eye out for those announcements!

This summer, the council would like very much to start to fully flesh out some of our smaller/single-person committees. If you are interested in stewardship (we have some new and expanded ideas for what this can mean!), education—both adult and youth—and evangelism/outreach, listen up for our upcoming announcements. We have a very dedicated council, but we need support in fleshing out some of the amazing ideas that we have! Speaking of support—council has openings for President, Treasurer and Secretary to be elected in June. Please let us know if you are interested in serving! We need YOU!




# JOIN IN THE FUN AT TRINITY
