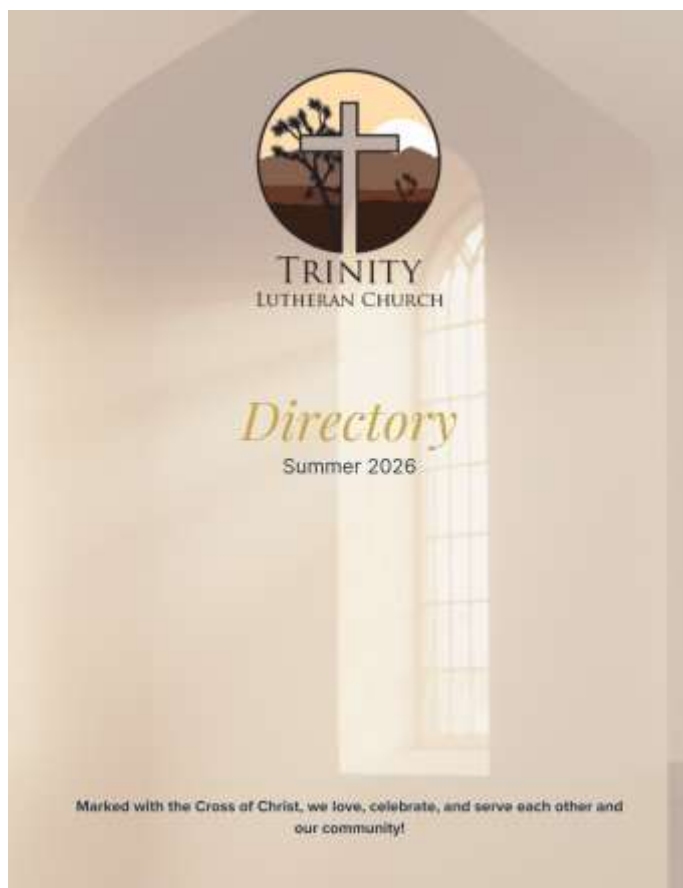

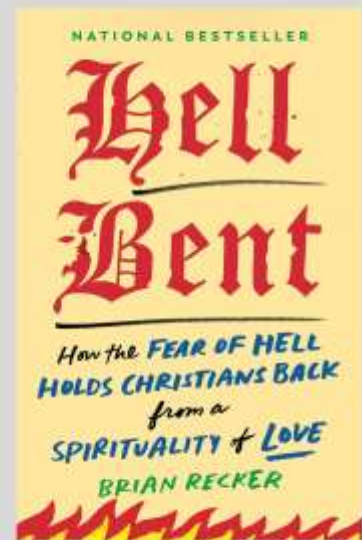

Hell Bent: How the Fear of Hell Holds Christians Back from a Spirituality of Love
by Brian Recker

Brian Recker takes an honest look at scripture and comes to a provocative conclusion: Hell isn't real, and God's universal love is radically inclusive, in this life and the next. By removing punishment from Christianity's center, Recker boldly reimagines the core questions of faith, such as why Jesus lived and died, and what it means to be "saved." Recker argues that it's time to rediscover spirituality as Jesus taught it: loving God, and loving our neighbors as ourselves.
